

Bigfoot Hydroponic Garden

Congratulations! You have just purchased a Bigfoot System that is simple to operate and will last many years. This is a do-it-yourself hobby kit so our detailed growing instructions are not included. Do not hesitate to ask your dealer for support. All our dealers are experts in hydroponic growing. Please read instructions thoroughly before you begin assembly.

Components:

- [2] 43" galvanized steel cross pieces
- [2] 24" galvanized steel legs with inserts
- [1] Optional 25 gallon Reservoir**
- [1] Via Aqua 360 pump with clamp
- [1] Tray with fittings and 1/2" vinyl tubing
- [4] Corners

Instructions:

1. Assemble table frame. Carefully insert 2 corner brackets into the ends of one cross piece. Repeat with another cross piece, then press remaining cross pieces in between the two. **DO NOT FORCE PLASTIC CORNERS.... THEY MAY BREAK!** Position unused "arm" of corners facing up, and press on legs. Turn table right side up and place over reservoir.
2. Install fittings in tray according to illustration. Fittings should be snug, not tight. A dab of Vaseline on the O-ring will insure a perfect seal.
3. Press vinyl tube over barbed end of fitting. Attach other end to pump with clamp provided. Use pliers to tighten clamp. Observe illustrations.
4. Place tray assembly onto table with pump attached.
5. Fill reservoir with water. Turn on pump - **NEVER LET PUMP RUN DRY.** You are ready to plant seeds in your medium of choice.
6. To drain reservoir, pull out fill/drain fitting screen and push in piece of 1/2" vinyl tube. Turn on pump to drain into bucket or into yard.

** If you have purchased a Bigfoot system without reservoir, you will need a 20 + gallon container that fits under the tray. Rubbermaid makes numerous sizes.
