Due to new industry regulations, Sunleaves® is updating the names and labels of certain products currently labeled as bat guanos.

These changes are the result of the Association of American Plant Food Control Officials' (AAPFCO) recently revised definition of "bat guano."

Because guanos are harvested in various states of decomposition, the organic matter content can vary widely among different guano sources. According to the new guidelines, decomposed fertilizers containing less than 40 percent organic material can no longer be labeled as "guano." This revised definition mainly affects high-phosphorus guanos, which are particularly prone to decomposing into mineral rock phosphate over time.

Sunleaves high-phosphorus products are now labeled as "Natural Fertilizer" (derived from rock phosphate) as a result. Our currently available Indonesian, Jamaican and Madagascan labels have been revised to comply with the new guidelines.

PLEASE NOTE: These changes only affect product names and packaging. Be assured these products will remain the same familiar fertilizer you trust, continuing to deliver the results you expect. No changes will be made to the product itself.
